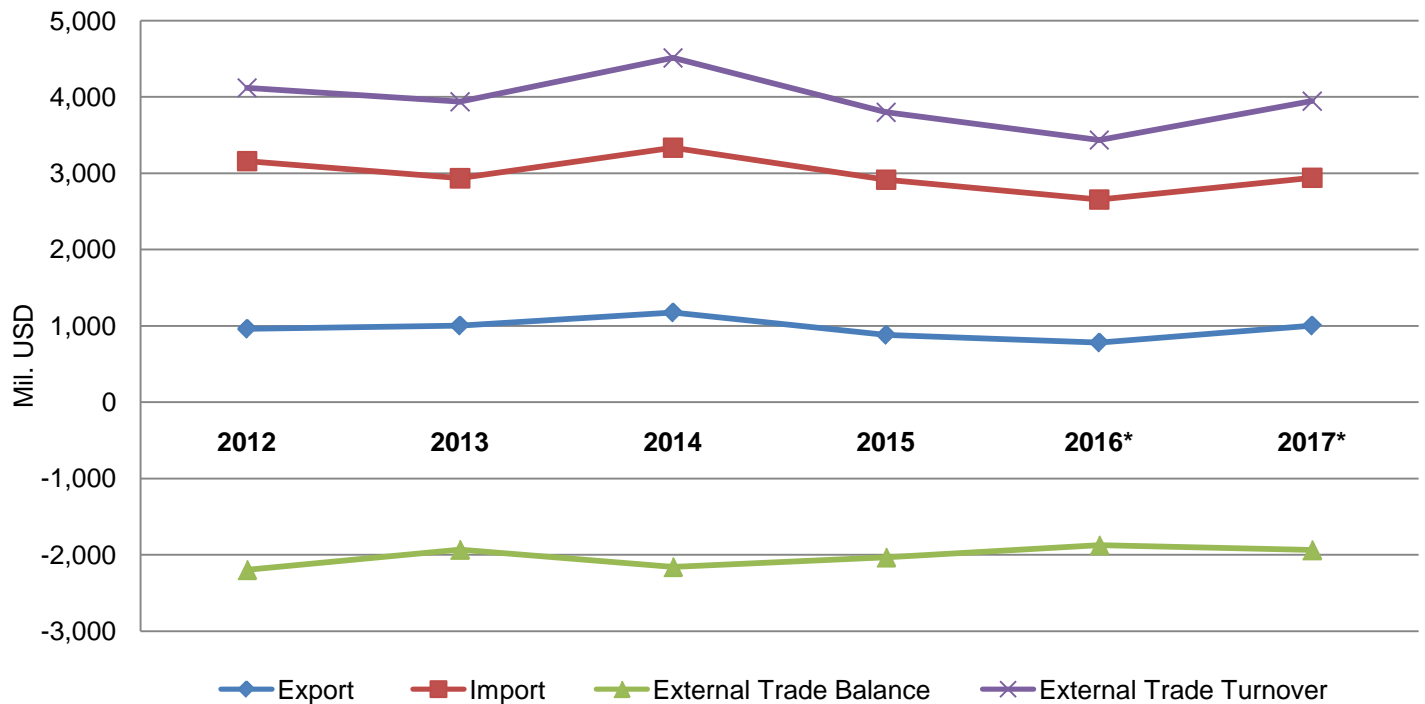

External Merchandise Trade of Georgia in January-May 2017 (Preliminary)

External Merchandise Trade (excluding non-declared trade) of Georgia amounted to USD 3945 million in January-May 2017 (preliminary data), grew by 15 percent from the same period of the previous year. The value of export increased by 29 percent reaching USD 1003 million, while the import grew by 11 percent and amounted to USD 2941 million with respect to January-May of the previous year. The trade deficit equaled USD 1938 million and its share in trade turnover constituted 49 percent.
