DOMESTIC PRODUCER PRICE INDEX FOR INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTS IN GEORGIA

MAY 2019

In May 2019 the Domestic Producer Price Index for Industrial Products (DPPI) decreased by 1.6 percent compared to the previous month. In the mentioned period the prices were 12.0 percent lower for electrical energy, gas, steam and hot water.

Compared to May 2018 the DPPI increased by 4.0 percent. The prices went up for manufactured products and for products from mining and quarrying by 6.9 and 4.4 percent, respectively. Meanwhile, the prices for electrical energy, gas, steam and hot water decreased by 10.2 percent.

The following table shows the DPPI for May 2019, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of sub-groups that had a major effect on the index.

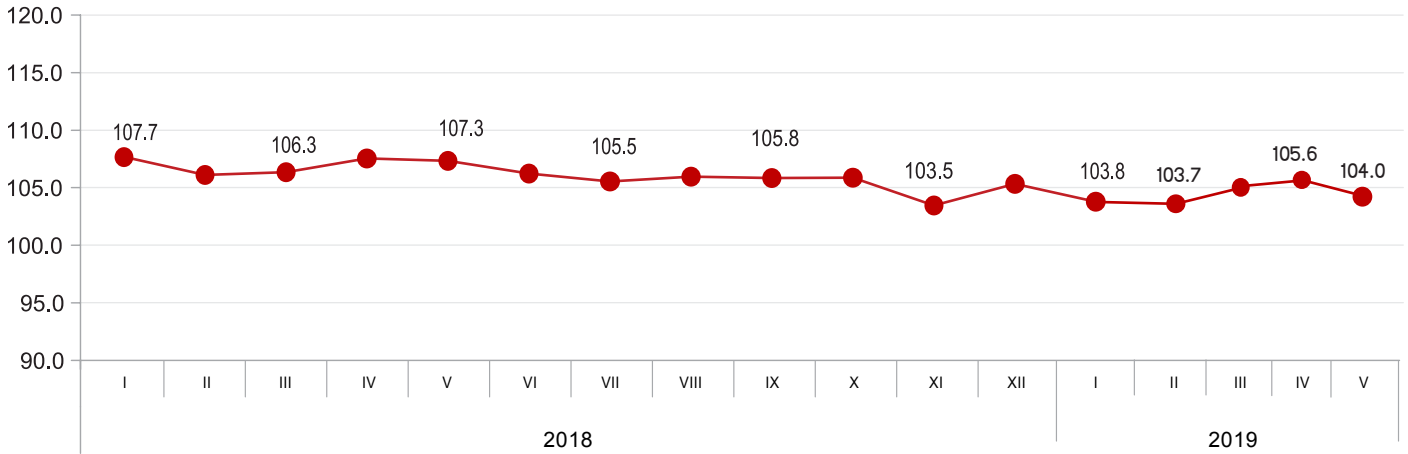
