## IMPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA MAY 2019

The Import Price Index (MPI) increased by 2.1 percent over the previous month, while compared to May 2018 the Index increased by 9.2 percent.

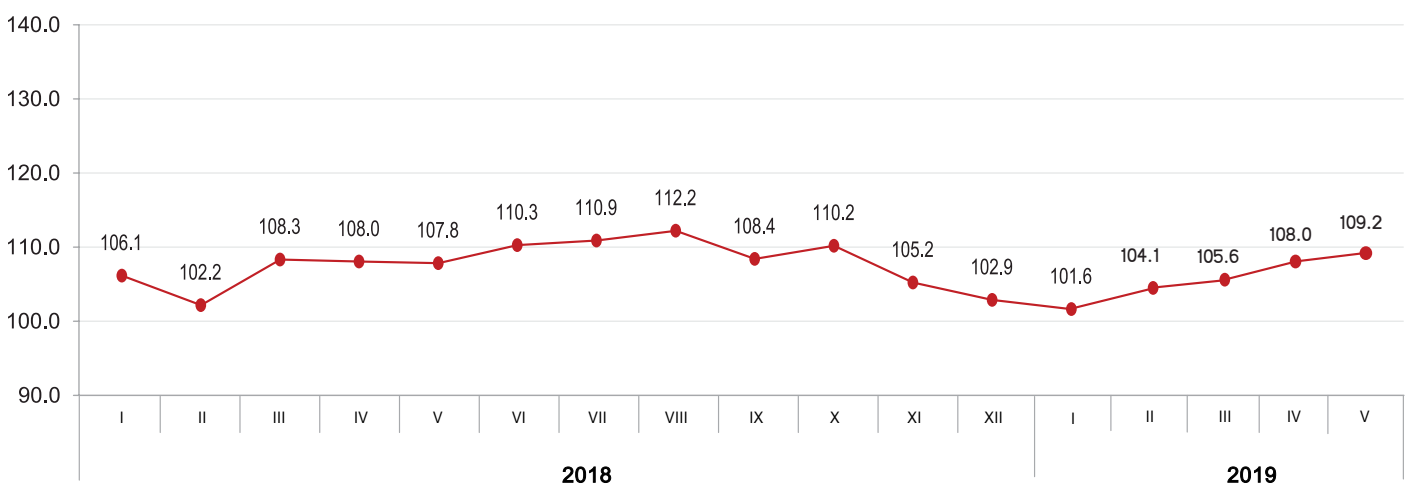
Compared to May 2018 the prices increased by 8.4 percent for manufactured products, while for products from mining and quarrying a price increase of 16.2 percent was registered. With regard to electrical energy, gas, steam and hot water, the prices were 11.7 percent higher.

The following table shows the MPI for May 2019, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of sub-groups that had a major effect on the index.
