(2018)

In 2018, the Research and Development in Georgia were conducted by 56 Institutions, of which 47 were Higher Education Institutions. Total expenditures on R&D equaled 128.3 Million GEL.


Number of employees in Research and Development equaled 15 522 persons, of which 11 174 were researchers. 53 percent of researchers are women and 47 percent are men.

65.6 percent of researchers has doctoral or equivalent degree, 30.1 percent - master's or equivalent degree and 4.2 percent - bachelor's or equivalent.



The largest part of researchers work in social sciences and their total number amounts to 2 745, while the smallest part of researchers work in agricultural and veterinary fields, where about 500 persons are employed.

The chart below presents the distribution of researchers by fields of science.


