
EXTERNAL MERCHANDISE TRADE OF GEORGIA IN JANUARY-MAY 2020

(PRELIMINARY)

In January-May 2020 the external merchandise trade (excluding non-declared trade) of Georgia amounted to USD 4 205.8 million, 16.8 percent lower to the same period of 2019. The exports equaled USD 1 235.7 million (16.2 percent lower), while the imports stood at USD 2 970.1 million (17.0 percent lower). The negative trade balance was USD 1 734.4 million in January-May 2020 and its share in external trade turnover constituted 41.2 percent.





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In January-May 2020 the share of the top ten trading partners by exports in the total exports of Georgia amounted to 77.2 percent. The top partners were China (USD 168.4 million), Azerbaijan (USD 167.4 million) and Russia (USD 157.1 million).




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TOP TRADING PARTNERS BY EXPORTS IN JANUARY-MAY 2019-2020(MILLION US DOLLARS)



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
TOP TRADING PARTNERS BY IMPORTS IN JANUARY-MAY 2019-2020



In January-May 2020 copper ores and concentrates reclaimed the first place in the list of top export items, equaling USD 258.1 million or 20.9 percent of total exports. The exports of motor cars totaled USD 148.9 million and their share in the total exports amounted to 12.0 percent. The Ferroalloys exports occupied the third place standing at USD 109.2 million and constituting 8.8 percent of the total exports.





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The top import commodities in January-May 2020 were motor cars whose imports equaled USD 222.8 million (7.5 percent of the total imports). The Copper ores and concentrates followed in the list with USD 199.1 million or 6.7 percent of imports. The petroleum and petroleum oils were third in the top import commodity list with USD 195.6 million (6.6 percent of imports).




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
