EXPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA AUGUST 2020

The Export Price Index (XPI) decreased by 1.0 percent compared to the previous month. There was a 1.9 percent decrease in the prices for manufactured products.

Compared to August 2019 the XPI increased by 7.2 percent. In the mentioned period the prices were higher for manufactured products by 4.7 percent and for products from mining and quarrying by 35.3 percent.

The following table shows the XPI for August 2020, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of sub-groups that had a major effect on the index:

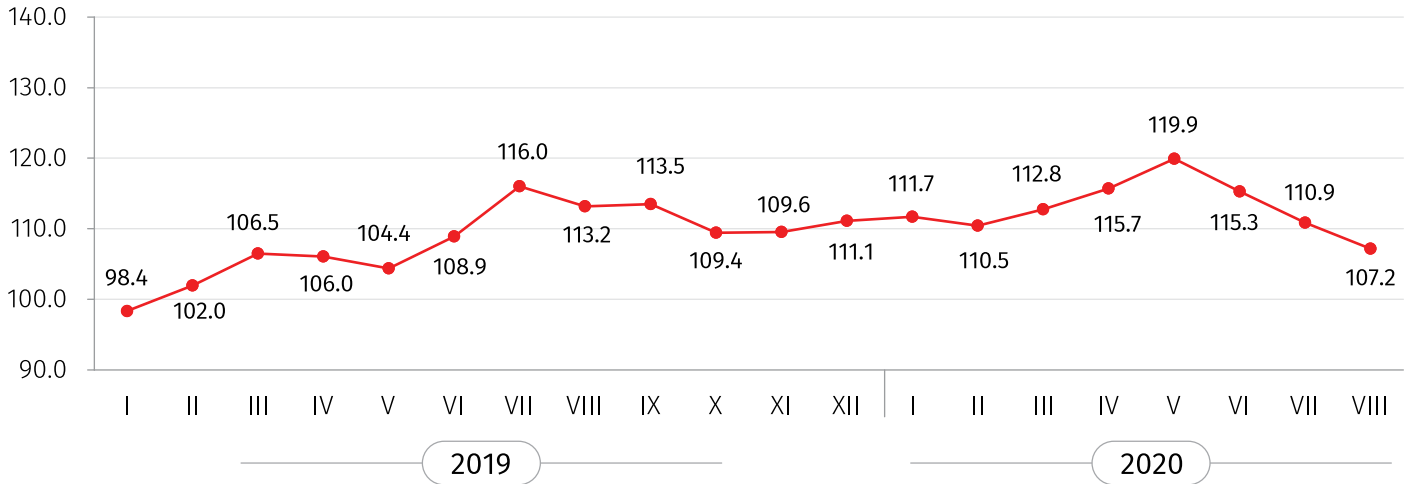
