INDICATORS OF LIVING CONDITIONS (HOUSEHOLDS INCOMES AND EXPENDITURES) 2020




In 2020 the average monthly incomes (cash and non-cash inflows) of the population in Georgia amounted to 1 194.6 million GEL, which is 4.5 percent decrease compared to 2019.

The chart below presents average monthly cash and non-cash inflows of the population for 2011-2020 years.

AVERAGE MONTHLY CASH AND NON-CASH INFLOWS OF THE POPULATION







According to the survey data of 2020, average monthly incomes decreased by 6.4 percent per household, by 4.4 per capita and amounted to 1100.5 GEL and 321.4 GEL correspondingly.

The chart below presents average monthly cash and non-cash inflows per household and per capita for 2011-2020 years.

According to the survey, the main source of incomes for households are cash incomes and transfers, which increased by 2.3 percent point y.o.y and reached 86.8 percent.


The chart below presents distribution of average monthly cash and non-cash inflows by main sources for 2011-2020 years.

The amount of households total incomes in urban areas decreased by 4.3 percent to 747.8 million GEL, while that of rural areas decreased by 5.0 percent to 446.9 million GEL.

In 2020, the income from wages has a significant contribution in the structure of cash incomes and transfers, the share of which decreased by 0.9 percentage points y.o.y and amounted to 47.8 percent. Additionally, the share of income from self-employment decreased by 2.0 percentage points and equaled 9.4 percent. Also, the share of income from pensions, scholarships and social assistance increased by 4.4 percentage points compared to the same period of the last year and amounted to 23.4 percent.


The chart below presents percentage distribution of cash incomes and transfers for 2020 year.




In 2020, the average monthly expenditures of the population in Georgia amounted to 1 127.3 million GEL, which is 7.6 percent decrease in comparison to the last year.

The chart below presents average monthly expenditures of the total population for 2011-2020 years.

According to the survey results, the average monthly expenditures per household decreased by 9.4 percent and is equal to 1 038.5 GEL, while the average monthly expenditures per capita decreased by 7.4 percent and amounted to 303.3 GEL.


The chart below presents average monthly expenditures per household and per capita for 2011-2020 years.

In 2020, the share of household cash consumption expenditures in total expenditures increased by 2.0 percent points compared to 2019 year and equals to 70.1 percent.


The chart below presents distribution of average monthly expenditures by the main categories for 2011-2020 years.

The amount of households expenditures in urban areas decreased by 6.5 percent and equals to 714.4 million GEL, while for rural areas decreased by 9.4 percent and amounted to 412.9 million GFL.

In 2020, expenditures on food, beverages, tobacco has a significant share in the structure of the cash consumption expenditures and amounted 42.1.


The chart below presents percentage distribution of cash consumption expenditures in 2020 year.
