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


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### EXTERNAL MERCHANDISE TRADE OF GEORGIA IN JANUARY-MAY 2021 (PRELIMINARY)

In January-May 2021 the external merchandise trade (excluding non-declared trade) of Georgia amounted to USD 5 019.4 million, 18.2 percent higher to the same period of 2020. The exports equaled USD 1 538.2 million (24.4 percent higher), while the imports stood at USD 3 481.3 million (15.7 percent higher). The negative trade balance was USD 1 943.1 million in January-May 2021 and its share in external trade turnover constituted 38.7 percent.










### GEORGIAN EXPORT BY COUNTRY GROUPS IN JANUARY-MAY 2021\*

In January-May 2021 the share of the top ten trading partners by exports in the total exports of Georgia amounted to 78.0 percent. The top partners were China (USD 262.5 million), Russia (USD 205.3 million) and Azerbaijan (USD 195.6 million).








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



### TOP TRADING PARTNERS BY IMPORTS IN JANUARY-MAY 2021




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TOP TRADING PARTNERS BY IMPORTS IN JANUARY-MAY 2020-2021 (MILLION US DOLLARS)

In January-May 2021 the share of the top ten trading partners in the total external trade turnover of Georgia amounted to 71.6 percent. The top trading partners were Turkey (USD 758.1 million), Russia (USD 598.7 million) and China (USD 552.0 million).

### TOP TRADING PARTNERS BY TURNOVER IN JANUARY-MAY 2021\*



In January-May 2021 copper ores and concentrates reclaimed the first place in the list of top export items, equaling USD 327.2 million or 21.3 percent of total exports. The exports of motor cars totaled USD 165.5 million and their share in the total exports amounted to 10.8 percent. The ferro-alloys exports occupied the third place standing at USD 144.3 million and constituting 9.4 percent of the total exports.







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
The top import commodities in January-May 2021 were motor cars whose imports equaled USD 309.2 million (8.9 percent of the total imports). The petroleum and petroleum oils followed in the list with USD 255.4 million or 7.3 percent of imports. The copper ores and concentrates were third in the top import commodity list with USD 233.9 million (6.7 percent of imports).


