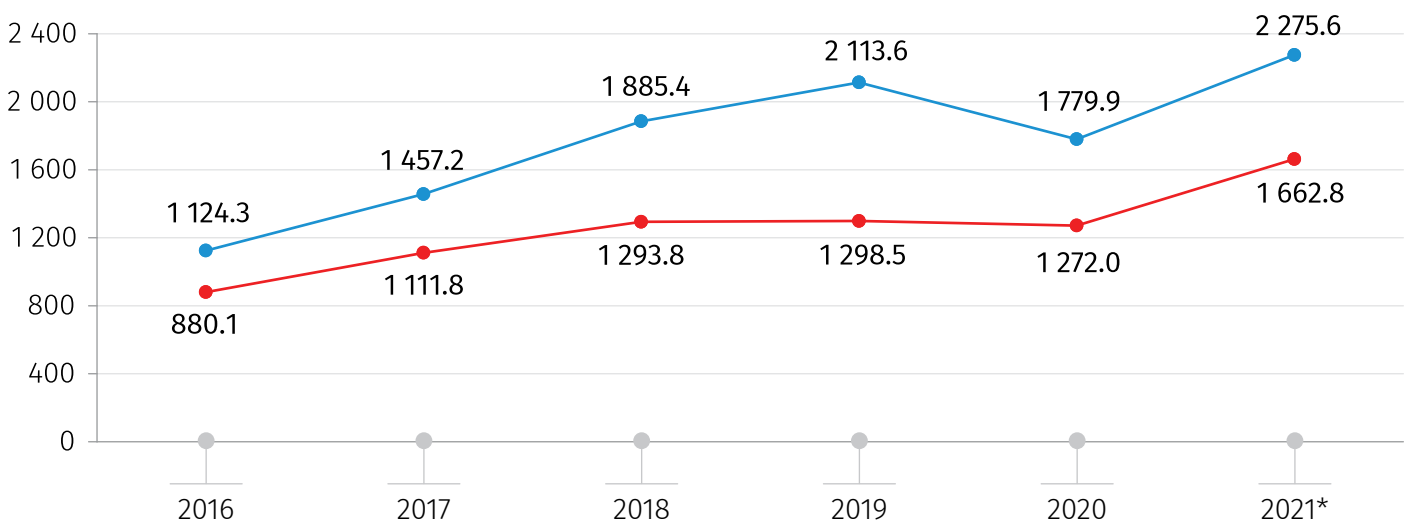

**THE DOMESTIC EXPORTS
IN JANUARY-JULY 2021**

In January-July 2021 the exports of Georgia (excluding non-declared exports) equaled USD 2 275.6 million, 27.8 percent higher year-on-year. Share of the domestic exports in total export constituted 73.1 percent and amounted to USD 1 662.8 million, 30.7 percent higher to the same period of 2020.

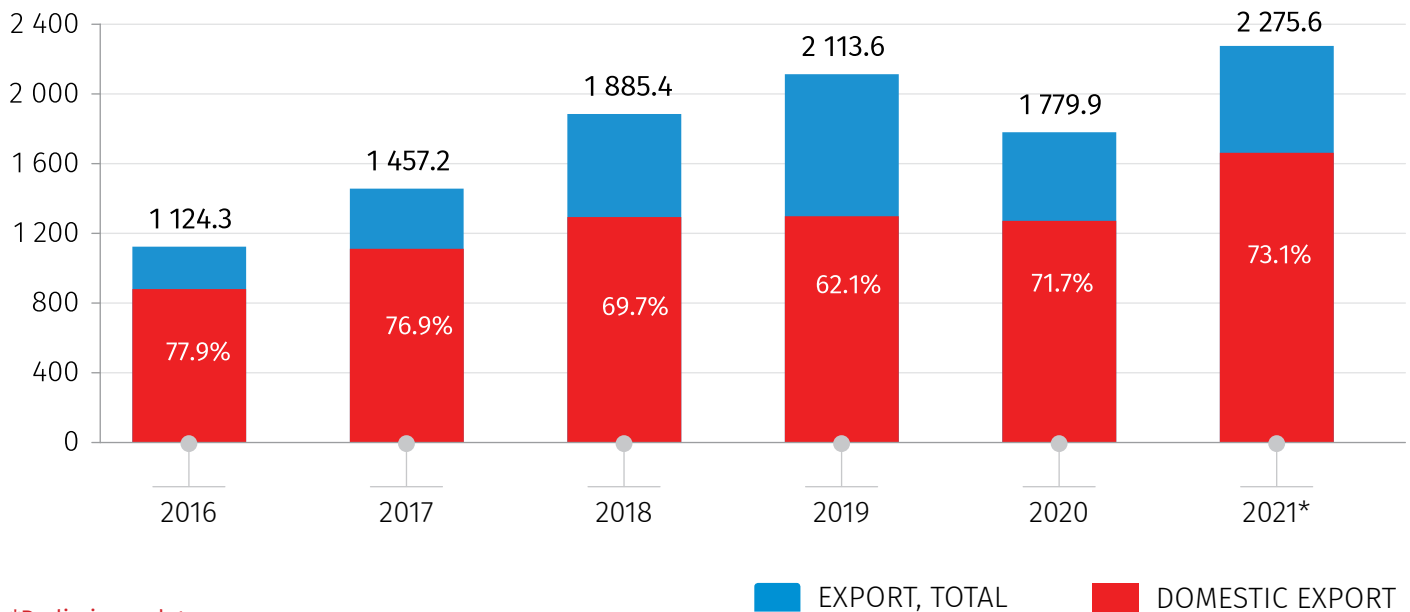

In January-July 2021 the share of the top ten trading partners by domestic exports in the total domestic exports of Georgia amounted to 79.8 percent. The top partners were China (USD 352.2 million), Russia (USD 293.9 million) and Turkey (USD 180.1 million).

In January-July 2021 copper ores and concentrates reclaimed the first place in the list of top export items, equaling USD 465.9 million, or 28.0 percent of total exports. The exports of ferro-alloys totaled USD 228.5 million and their share in the total exports amounted to 13.7 percent. The exports of wine of fresh grapes occupied the third place standing at USD 123.9 million and constituting 7.4 percent of the total exports.

Domestic exports include export of goods produced in the country, as well as imported from abroad, the value of which has significantly changed as a result of domestic processing.
