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
EXTERNAL MERCHANDISE TRADE OF GEORGIA **IN JANUARY-SEPTEMBER 2021**

(PRELIMINARY)

In January-September 2021 the external merchandise trade (excluding non-declared trade) of Georgia amounted to USD 10 009.7 million, 22.3 percent higher to the same period of 2020. The exports equaled USD 2 981.3 million (24.0 percent higher), while the imports stood at USD 7 028.4 million (21.6 percent higher). The negative trade balance was USD 4 047.1 million in January-September 2021 and its share in external trade turnover constituted 40.4 percent.





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
EXPORTS AND IMPORTS DYNAMICS BY MONTHS, 2019-2021

GEORGIAN EXPORT BY COUNTRY GROUPS IN JANUARY-SEPTEMBER 2021*








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TOP TRADING PARTNERS BY EXPORTS IN JANUARY-SEPTEMBER 2020-2021(MILLION US DOLLARS)



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
TOP TRADING PARTNERS BY IMPORTS IN JANUARY-SEPTEMBER 2020-2021



In January-September 2021 copper ores and concentrates reclaimed the first place in the list of top export items, equaling USD 571.7 million with 19.2 percent of total exports. The exports of Motor cars totaled USD 338.2 million and their share in the total exports amounted to 11.3 percent. The Ferro-alloys exports occupied the third place standing at USD 316.5 million and constituting 10.6 percent of the total exports.



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The top import commodities in January-September 2021 were motor cars whose imports equaled USD 632.5 million (9.0 percent of the total imports). The petroleum and petroleum oils followed in the list with USD 576.3 million (8.2 percent of imports). The copper ores and concentrates were third in the top import commodity list with USD 530.2 million (7.5 percent of imports).


