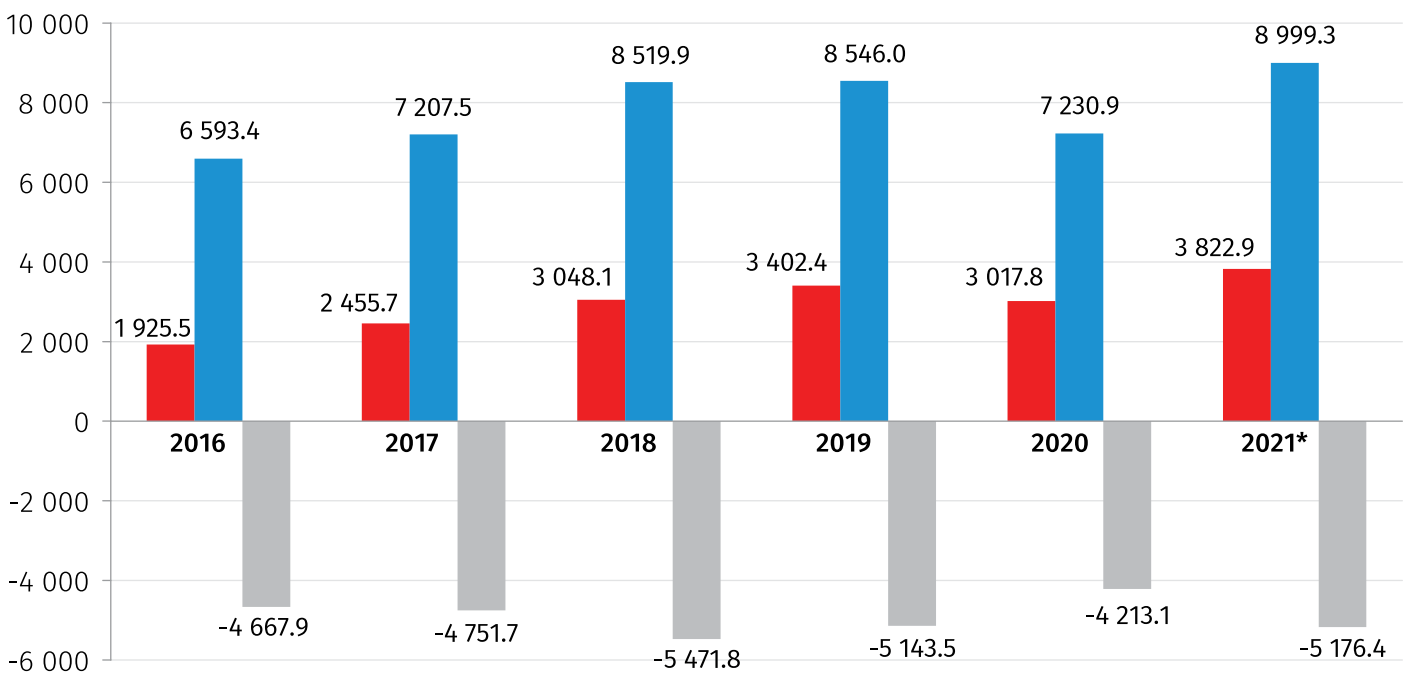

**EXTERNAL MERCHANDISE TRADE OF GEORGIA  
IN JANUARY-NOVEMBER 2021  
(PRELIMINARY)**

In January-November 2021 the external merchandise trade (excluding non-declared trade) of Georgia amounted to USD 12 822.2 million, 25.1 percent higher to the same period of 2020. The exports equaled USD 3 822.9 million (26.7 percent higher), while the imports stood at USD 8 999.3 million (24.5 percent higher). The negative trade balance was USD 5 176.4 million in January-November 2021 and its share in external trade turnover constituted 40.4 percent.

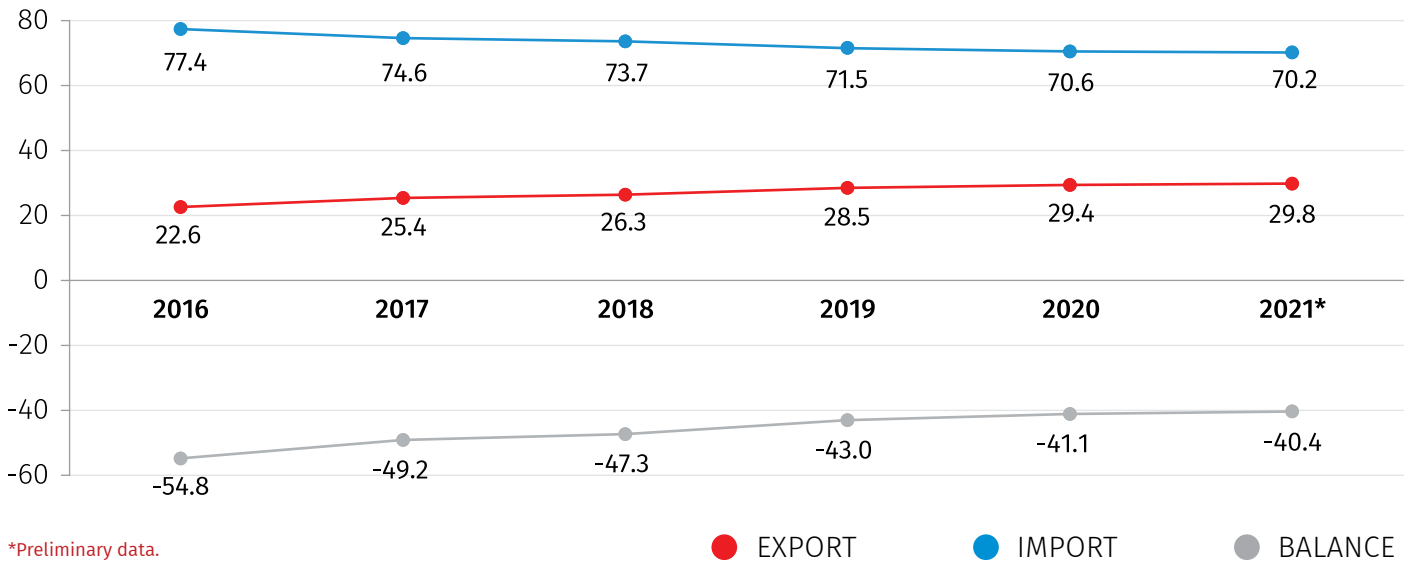

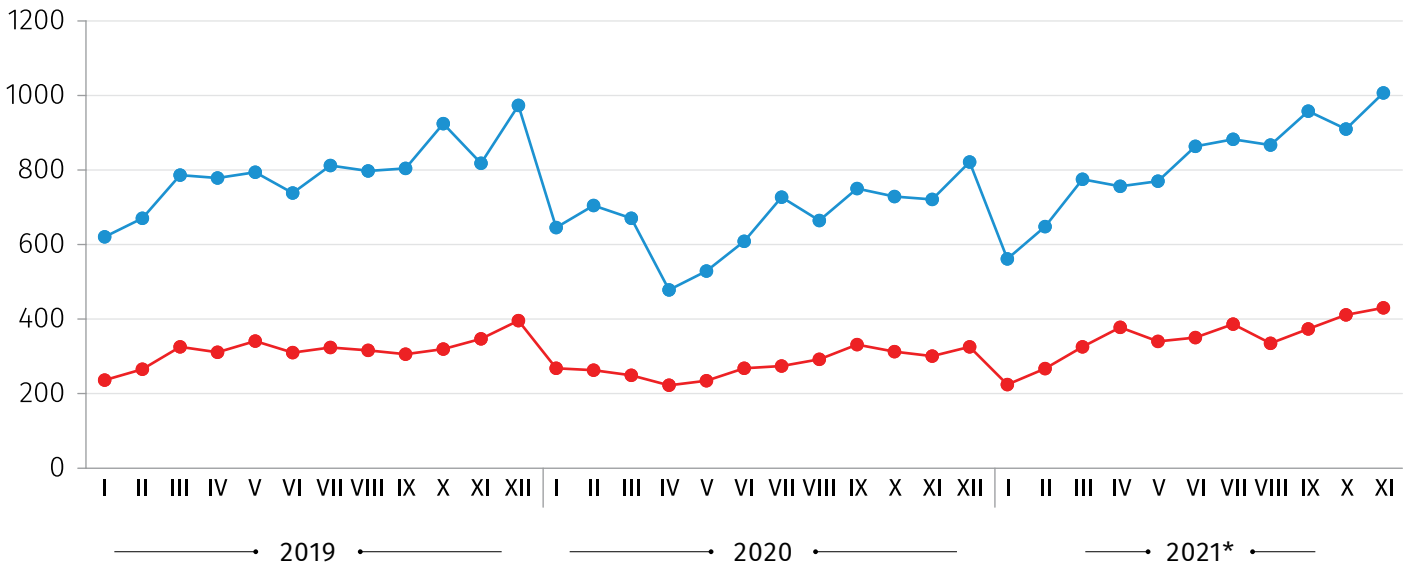

### EXPORTS AND IMPORTS DYNAMICS BY MONTHS, 2019-2021 (MILLION US DOLLARS)

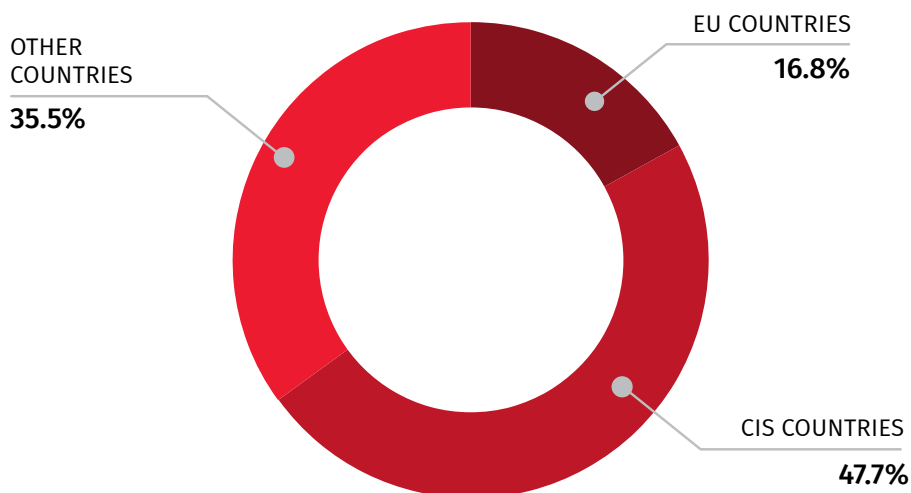

### GEORGIAN EXPORT BY COUNTRY GROUPS IN JANUARY-NOVEMBER 2021\*

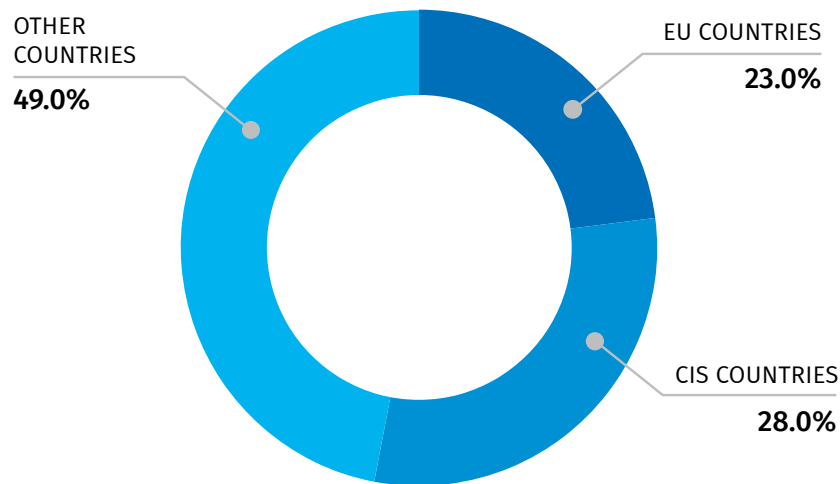

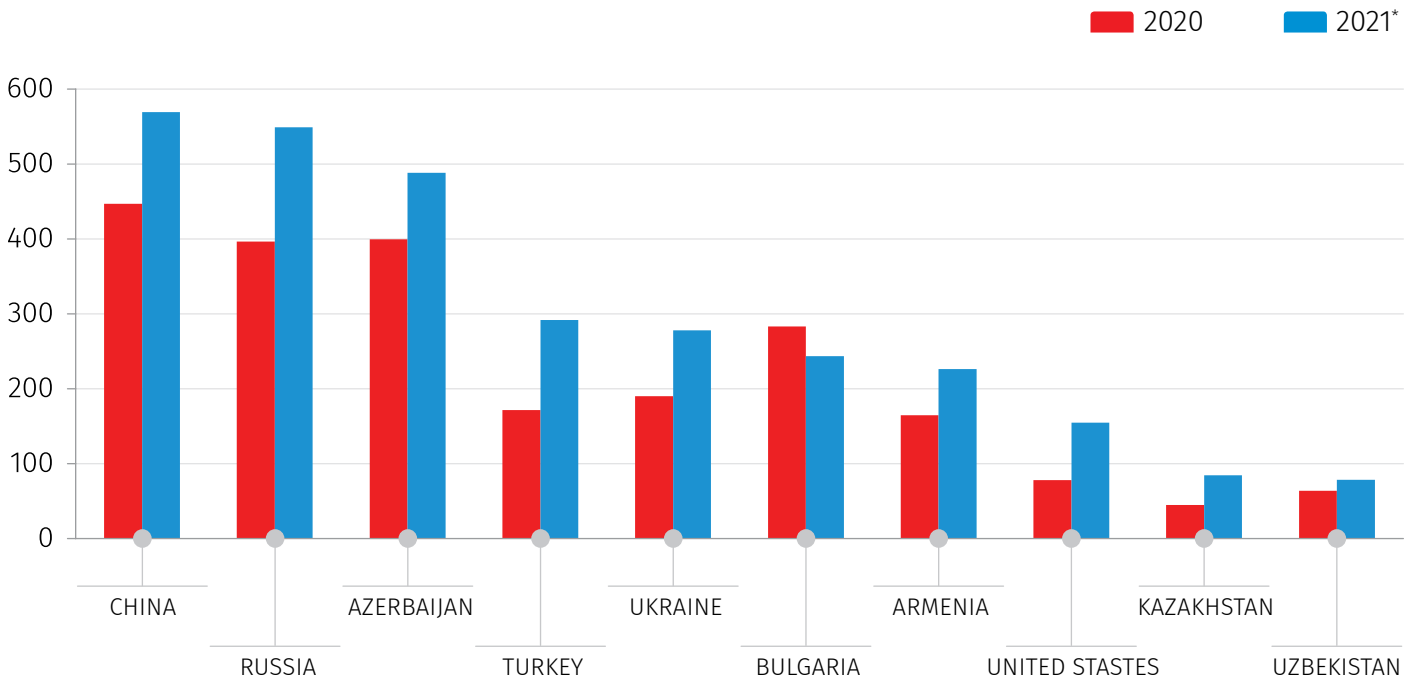

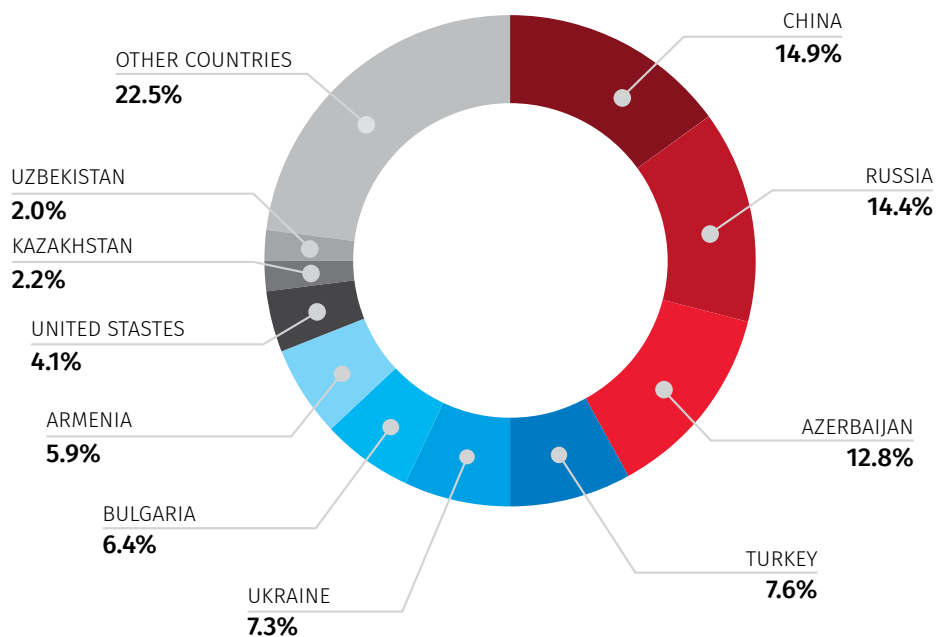

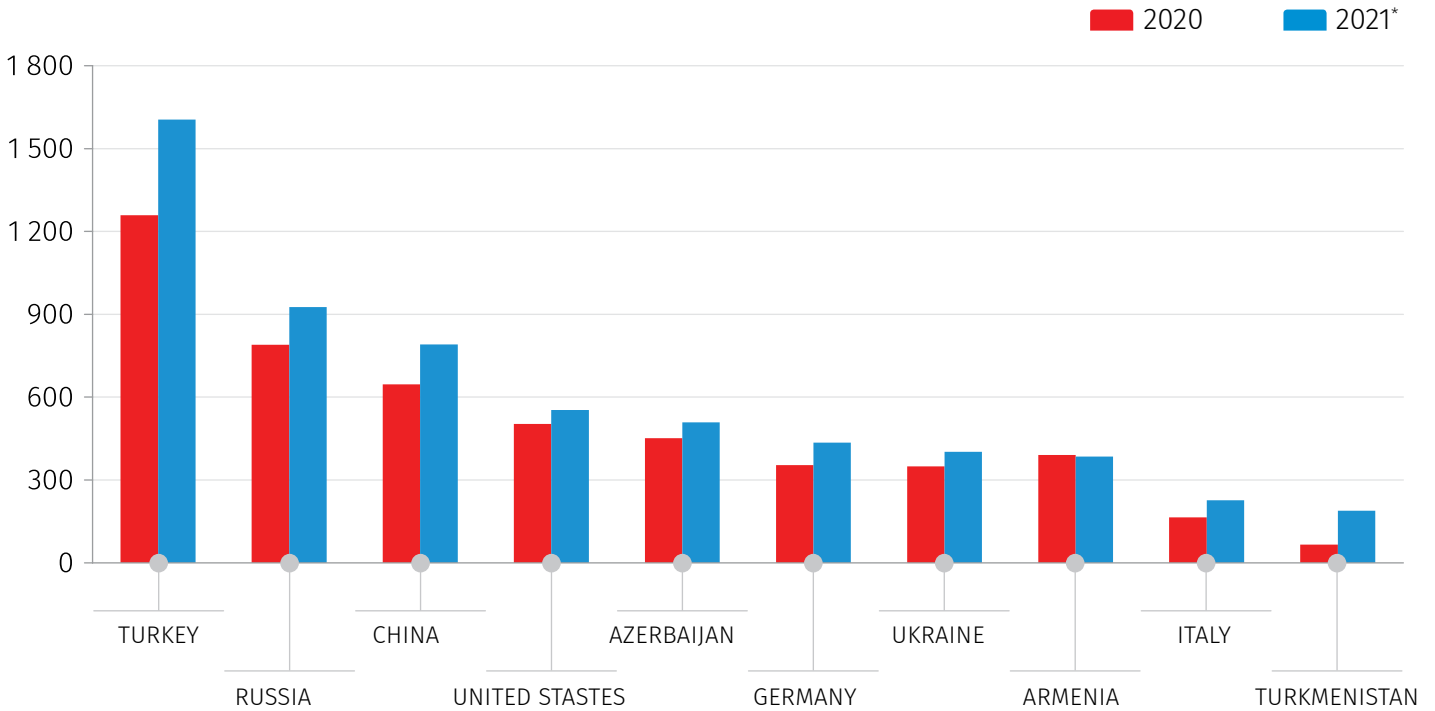

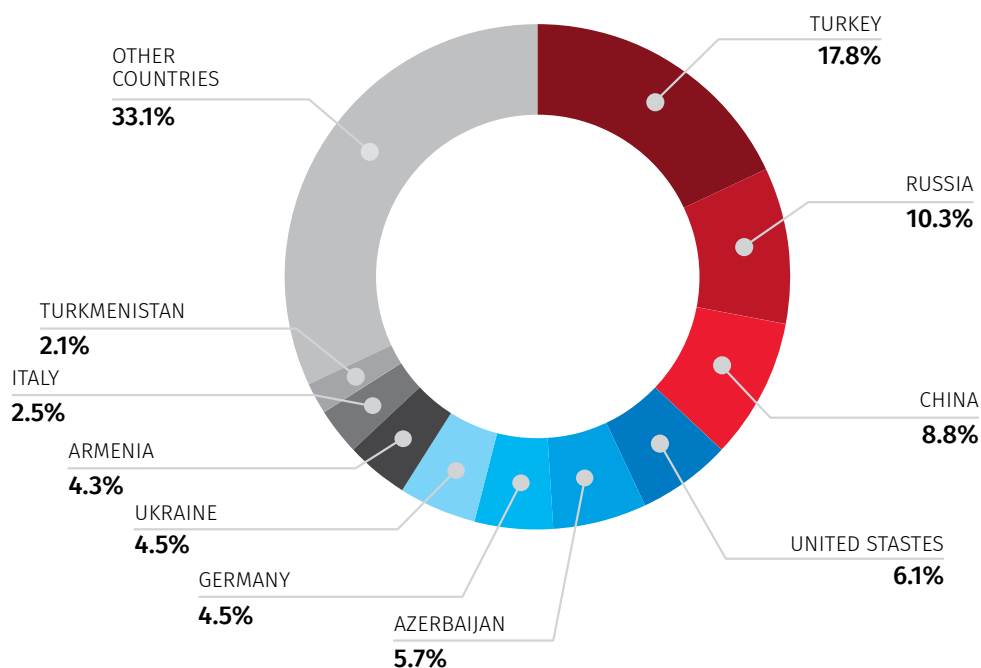

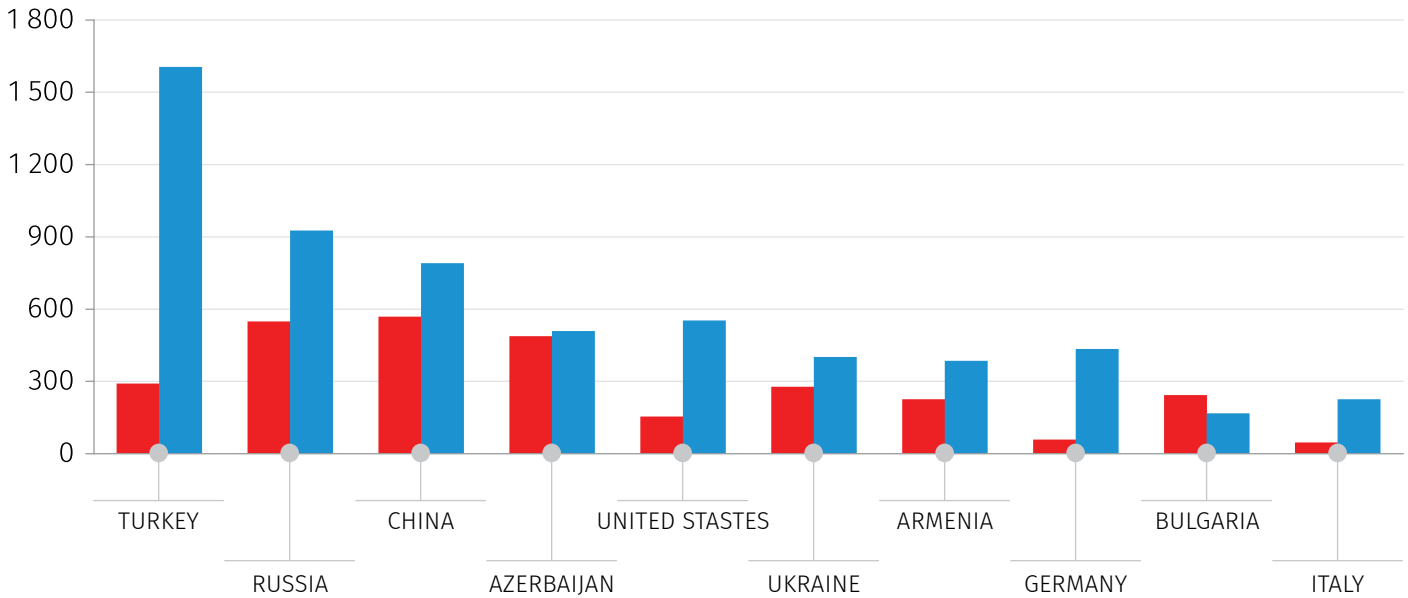

In January-November 2021 copper ores and concentrates reclaimed the first place in the list of top export items, equaling USD 750.1 million with 19.6 percent of total exports. The exports of motor cars totaled USD 417.6 million and their share in the total exports amounted to 10.9 percent. The ferro-alloys exports occupied the third place standing at USD 414.8 million and constituting 10.8 percent of the total exports.

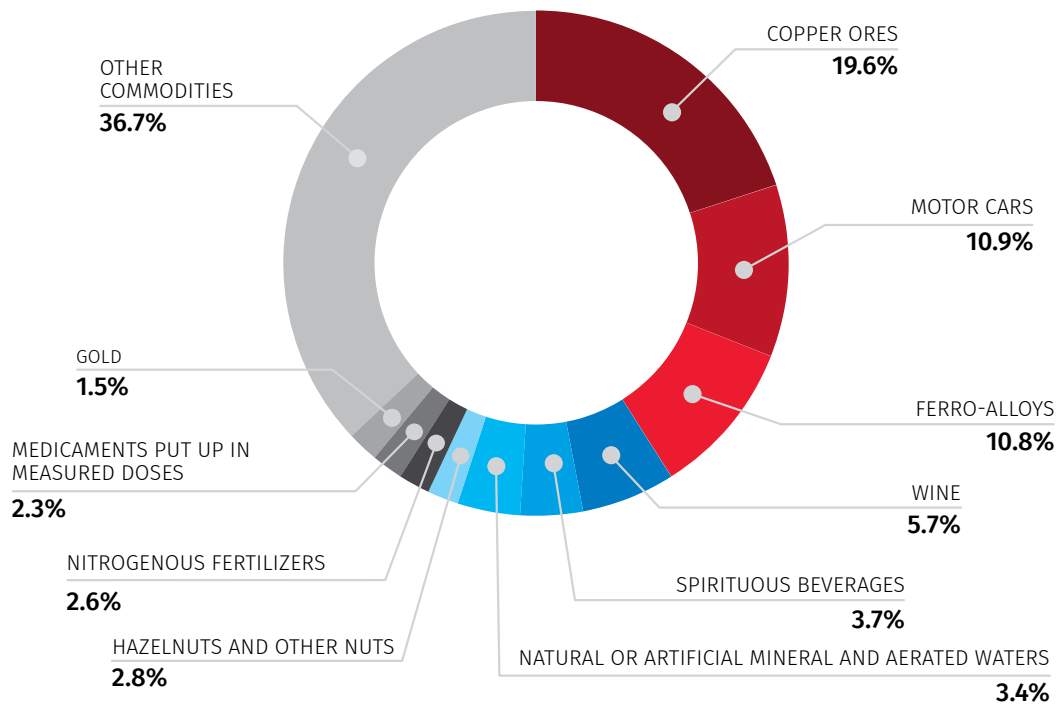

The copper ores and concentrates were third in the top import commodity list with USD 668.3 million (7.4 percent of imports).

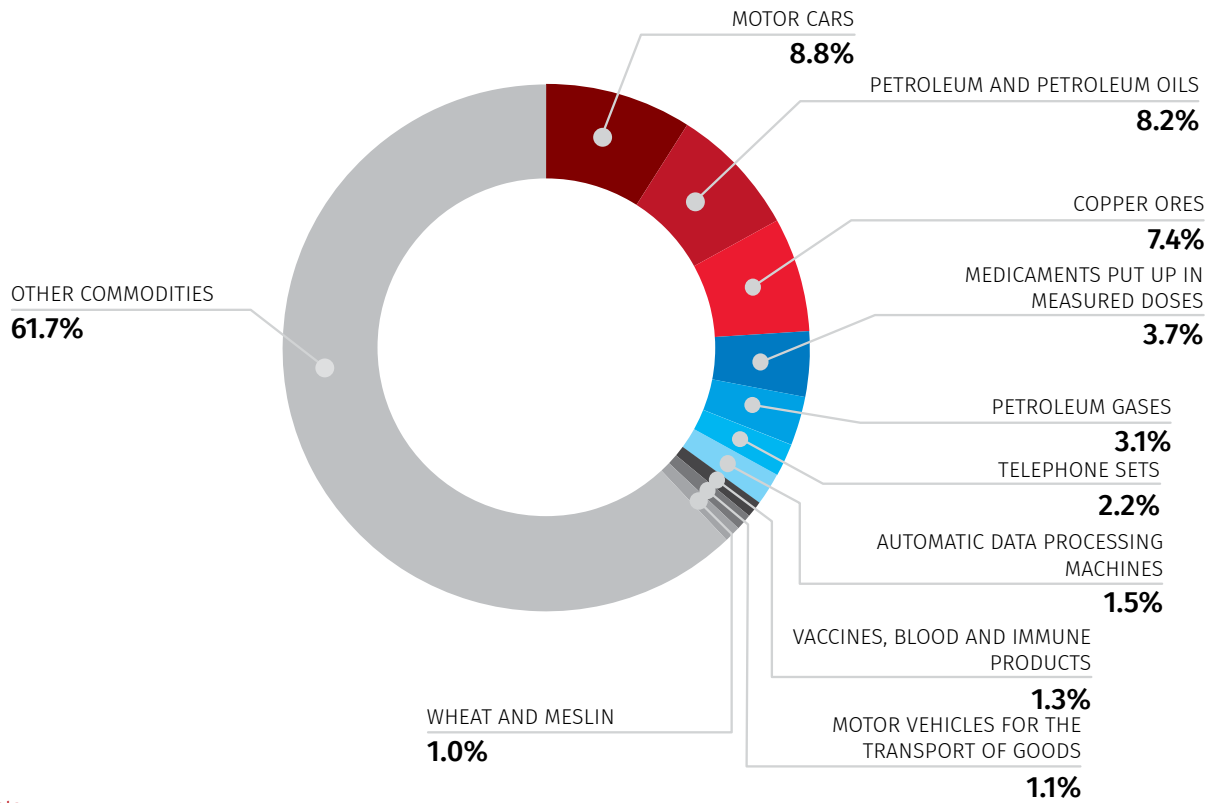
