
EXTERNAL MERCHANDISE TRADE OF GEORGIA IN JANUARY-FEBRUARY 2022

(PRELIMINARY)

In January-February 2022 the external merchandise trade (excluding non-declared trade) of Georgia amounted to USD 2 542.1 million, 49.3 percent higher to the same period of 2021. The exports equaled USD 760.4 million (54.5 percent higher), while the imports stood at USD 1 781.7 million (47.2 percent higher). The negative trade balance was USD 1 021.3 million in January-February 2022 and its share in external trade turnover constituted 40.2 percent.






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SHARE OF EXTERNAL TRADE INDICATORS IN TURNOVER JANUARY-FEBRUARY 2017-2022

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

GEORGIAN EXPORT BY COUNTRY GROUPS IN JANUARY-FEBRUARY 2022*





In January-February 2022 the share of the top ten trading partners by exports in the total exports of Georgia amounted to 78.0 percent. The top partners were China (USD 95.4 million), Russia (USD 92.9 million) and Azerbaijan (USD 92.3 million).



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
TOP TRADING PARTNERS BY EXPORTS IN JANUARY-FEBRUARY 2021-2022



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
TOP TRADING PARTNERS BY IMPORTS IN JANUARY-FEBRUARY 2021-2022

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In January-February 2022 the share of the top ten trading partners in the total external trade turnover of Georgia amounted to 67.3 percent. The top trading partners were Turkey (USD 354.4 million), Russia (USD 274.6 million) and Azerbaijan (USD 248.8 million).



In January-February 2022 copper ores and concentrates reclaimed the first place in the list of top export items, equaling USD 156.3 million with 20.6 percent of total exports. The exports of ferro-alloys totaled USD 100.5 million and their share in the total exports amounted to 13.2 percent. The motor cars exports occupied the third place standing at USD 72.6 million and constituting 9.5 percent of the total exports.



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The top import commodities in January-February 2022 were petroleum and petroleum oils whose imports equaled USD 162.7 million (9.1 percent of the total imports). The Copper ores and concentrates followed in the list with USD 153.9 million (8.6 percent of imports). The motor cars were third in the top import commodity list with USD 134.0 million (7.5 percent of imports).


