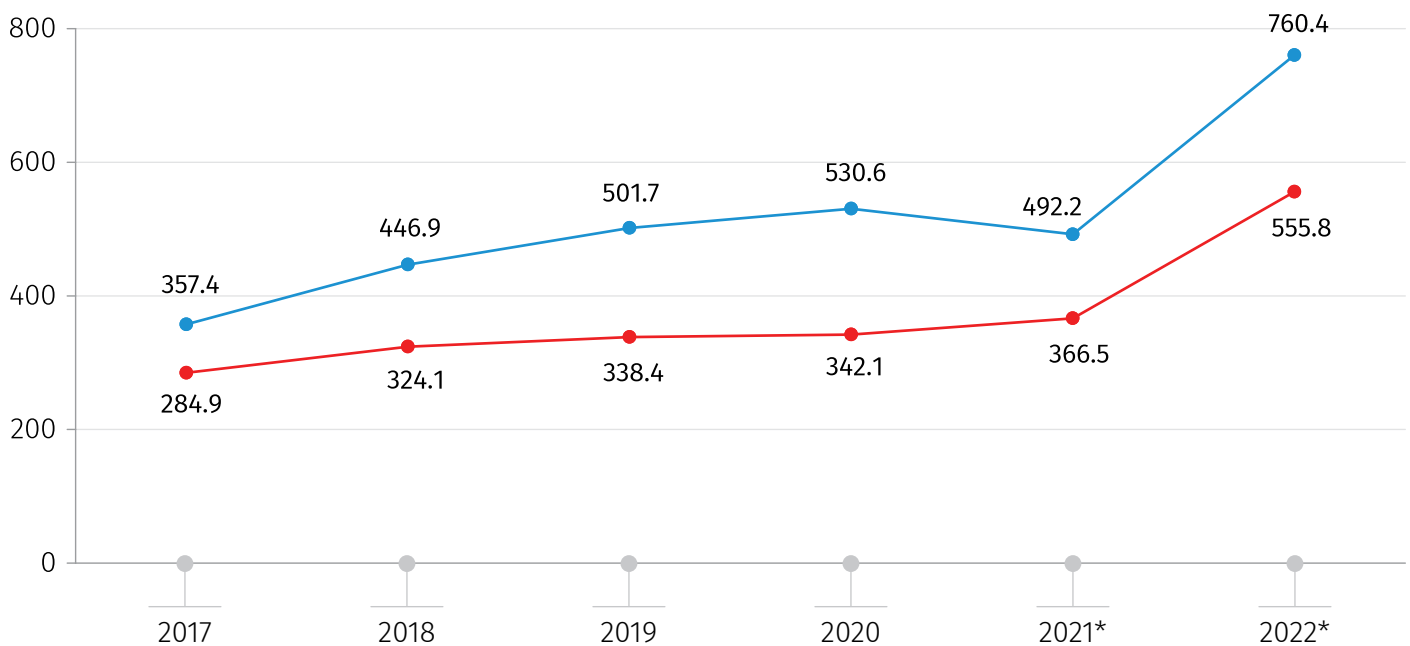

THE DOMESTIC EXPORTS IN JANUARY-FEBRUARY 2022

In January-February 2022 the exports of Georgia (excluding non-declared exports) equaled USD 760.4 million, 54.5 percent higher year-on-year. Share of the domestic exports in total export constituted 73.1 percent and amounted to USD 555.8 million, 51.7 percent higher to the same period of 2021.

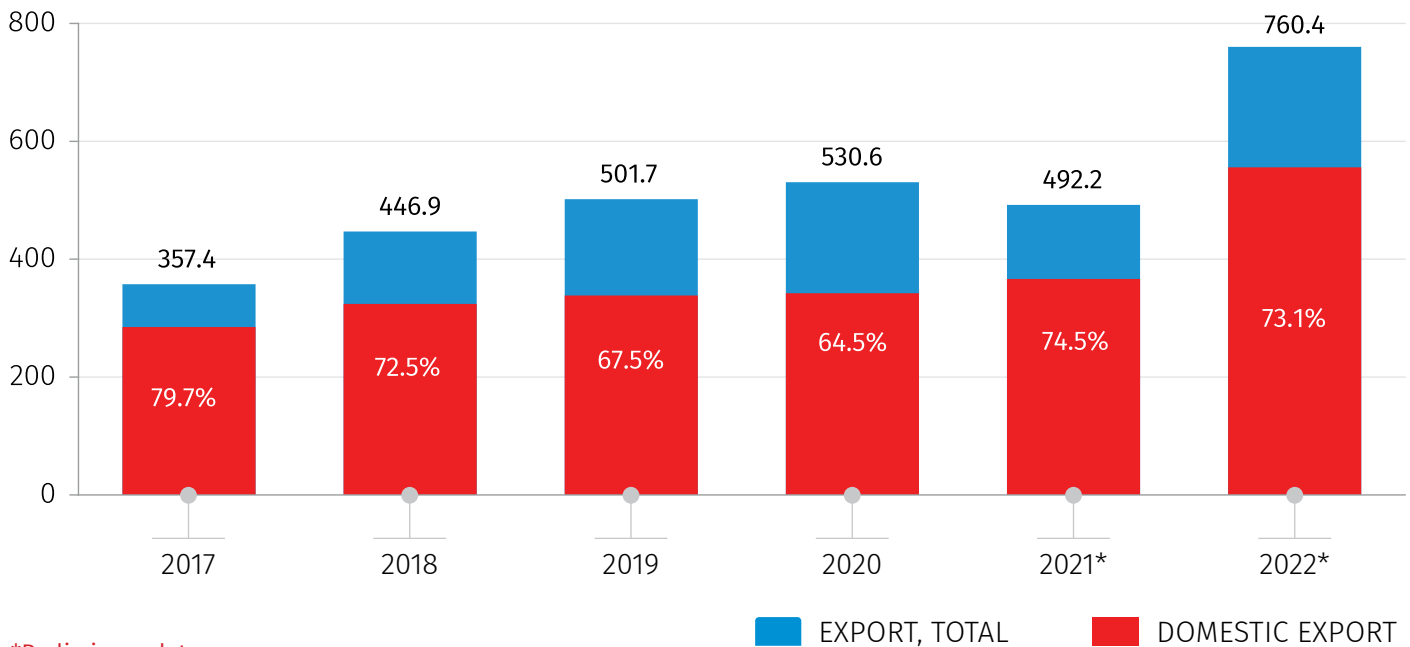

In January-February 2022 the share of the top ten trading partners by domestic exports in the total domestic exports of Georgia amounted to 80.8 percent. The top partners were China (USD 90.0 million), Bulgaria (USD 83.7 million) and Russia (USD 80.2 million).

In January-February 2022 copper ores and concentrates reclaimed the first place in the list of top export items, equaling USD 156.3 million, or 28.1 percent of total exports. The exports of ferro-alloys totaled USD 100.5 million and their share in the total exports amounted to 18.1 percent. The exports of nitrogenous fertilizers occupied the third place standing at USD 58.2 million and constituting 10.5 percent of the total exports.

 4. According to the international methodology, there are some differences in coverage of trade flows between external merchandise trade statistics and customs statistics. Diplomatic, temporary, transit and analogous goods are excluded from the database of external merchandise trade statistics.

The preliminary data will be revised according to the Geostat's revision policy (based on the regular revision principle) as a result of adjusting data by respondents/administrative sources.

Domestic exports include export of goods produced in the country, as well as imported from abroad, the value of which has significantly changed as a result of domestic processing.
