
EXTERNAL MERCHANDISE TRADE OF GEORGIA IN JANUARY-APRIL 2022

(PRELIMINARY)

In January-April 2022 the external merchandise trade (excluding non-declared trade) of Georgia amounted to USD 5 253.7 million, 33.4 percent higher to the same period of 2021. The exports equaled USD 1 587.5 million (32.8 percent higher), while the imports stood at USD 3 666.2 million (33.7 percent higher). The negative trade balance was USD 2 078.6 million in January-April 2022 and its share in external trade turnover constituted 39.6 percent.





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
EXPORTS AND IMPORTS DYNAMICS BY MONTHS, 2020-2022

GEORGIAN EXPORT BY COUNTRY GROUPS IN JANUARY-APRIL 2022*





In January-April 2022 the share of the top ten trading partners by exports in the total exports of Georgia amounted to 77.3 percent. The top partners were China (USD 290.4 million), Azerbaijan (USD 168.4 million) and Russia (USD 156.4 million).



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
TOP TRADING PARTNERS BY EXPORTS IN JANUARY-APRIL 2021-2022



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
TOP TRADING PARTNERS BY IMPORTS IN JANUARY-APRIL 2021-2022

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In January-April 2022 the share of the top ten trading partners in the total external trade turnover of Georgia amounted to 68.3 percent. The top trading partners were Turkey (USD 766.3 million), China (USD 614.7 million) and Russia (USD 559.7 million).



In January-April 2022 copper ores and concentrates reclaimed the first place in the list of top export items, equaling USD 363.3 million with 22.9 percent of total exports. The exports of ferro-alloys totaled USD 195.4 million and their share in the total exports amounted to 12.3 percent. The motor cars exports occupied the third place standing at USD 132.0 million and constituting 8.3 percent of the total exports.



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The top import commodities in January-April 2022 were petroleum and petroleum oils whose imports equaled USD 337.1 million (9.2 percent of the total imports). The motor cars followed in the list with USD 319.7 million (8.7 percent of imports). The copper ores and concentrates were third in the top import commodity list with USD 266.0 million (7.3 percent of imports).


