## **INDICATORS OF LIVING CONDITIONS** (HOUSEHOLDS INCOMES AND EXPENDITURES) 2021


**INCOMES** 

In 2021 the average monthly incomes (cash and non-cash inflows) of the population in Georgia amounted to 1 360.2 million GEL, which is 13.9 percent increase compared to 2020.

The chart below presents average monthly cash and non-cash inflows of the population for 2011-2021 years.

#### AVERAGE MONTHLY CASH AND NON-CASH INFLOWS OF THE POPULATION







According to the survey data of 2021, average monthly incomes increased by 11.0 percent per household, by 13.5 per capita and amounted to 1 221.8 GEL and 364.8 GEL correspondingly.

According to the survey, the main source of incomes for households are cash incomes and transfers, which decreased by 0.8 percent point y.o.y and reached 86.0 percent.


The chart below presents distribution of average monthly cash and non-cash inflows by main sources for 2011-2021 years.

## DISTRIBUTION OF AVERAGE MONTHLY CASH AND NON-CASH INFLOWS BY MAIN SOURCES (%)



The amount of households total incomes in urban areas increased by 12.7 percent to GEL 842.6 million, while that of rural areas increased by 15.8 percent to GEL 517.6 million.

In 2021, the income from wages has a significant contribution in the structure of cash incomes and transfers, the share of which decreased by 1.9 percentage points y.o.y and amounted to 45.9 percent. Additionally, the share of income from self-employment increased by 0.8 percentage points and equaled 10.2 percent. Also, the share of income from pensions, scholarships and social assistance decreased by 0.8 percentage points compared to the same period of the last year and amounted to 22.6 percent.






In 2021, the average monthly expenditures of the population in Georgia amounted to 1 289.5 million GEL, which is 14.4 percent increase in comparison to the last year.

The chart below presents average monthly expenditures of the total population for 2011-2021 years.

According to the survey results, the average monthly expenditures per household increased by 11.5 percent and is equal to 1 158.3 GEL, while the average monthly expenditures per capita increased by 14.0 percent and amounted to 345.9 GEL.



In 2021, the share of household cash consumption expenditures in total expenditures is nearly the same compared to 2020 year and equals to 70.1 percent.

The amount of households expenditures in urban areas increased by 11.7 percent and equals to 798.3 million GEL, while for rural areas increased by 19.0 percent and amounted to 491.2 million GEL.

In 2021, expenditures on food, beverages, tobacco has a significant share in the structure of the cash consumption expenditures and amounted 43.7 percent.


The chart below presents percentage distribution of cash consumption expenditures in 2021 year.
