EXTERNAL MERCHANDISE TRADE OF GEORGIA IN JANUARY-MAY 2022

(PRELIMINARY)

In January-May 2022 the external merchandise trade (excluding non-declared trade) of Georgia amounted to USD 6 933.6 million, 37.4 percent higher to the same period of 2021. The exports equaled USD 2 112.1 million (37.5 percent higher), while the imports stood at USD 4 821.5 million (37.3 percent higher). The negative trade balance was USD 2 709.4 million in January-May 2022 and its share in external trade turnover constituted 39.1 percent.





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
EXPORTS AND IMPORTS DYNAMICS BY MONTHS, 2020-2022

GEORGIAN EXPORT BY COUNTRY GROUPS IN JANUARY-MAY 2022*







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
TOP TRADING PARTNERS BY EXPORTS IN JANUARY-MAY 2021-2022



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
TOP TRADING PARTNERS BY IMPORTS IN JANUARY-MAY 2021-2022



In January-May 2022 copper ores and concentrates reclaimed the first place in the list of top export items, equaling USD 465.9 million with 22.1 percent of total exports. The exports of ferroalloys totaled USD 285.7 million and their share in the total exports amounted to 13.5 percent. The motor cars exports occupied the third place standing at USD 191.0 million and constituting 9.0 percent of the total exports.



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The top import commodities in January-May 2022 were petroleum and petroleum oils whose imports equaled USD 461.2 million (9.6 percent of the total imports). The motor cars followed in the list with USD 454.7 million (9.4 percent of imports). The copper ores and concentrates were third in the top import commodity list with USD 371.8 million (7.7 percent of imports).




