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


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EXTERNAL MERCHANDISE TRADE OF GEORGIA IN JANUARY-JUNE 2022 (PRELIMINARY)

In January-June 2022 the external merchandise trade (excluding non-declared trade) of Georgia amounted to USD 8 477.4 million, 35.4 percent higher to the same period of 2021. The exports equaled USD 2 558.7 million (35.6 percent higher), while the imports stood at USD 5 918.6 million (35.3 percent higher). The negative trade balance was USD 3 359.9 million in January-June 2022 and its share in external trade turnover constituted 39.6 percent.

The charts below reflect basic trends of the external merchandise trade of Georgia:








GEORGIAN EXPORT BY COUNTRY GROUPS IN JANUARY-JUNE 2022*

In January-June 2022 the share of the top ten trading partners by exports in the total exports of Georgia amounted to 79.0 percent. The top partners were China (USD 400.0 million), Azerbaijan (USD 287.0 million) and Russia (USD 256.5 million).






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
TOP TRADING PARTNERS BY EXPORTS IN JANUARY-JUNE 2021-2022

SHARE OF THE TOP TRADING PARTNERS IN TOTAL EXPORTS IN JANUARY-JUNE 2022*



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

TOP TRADING PARTNERS BY IMPORTS IN JANUARY-JUNE 2022



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


TOP TRADING PARTNERS BY IMPORTS IN JANUARY-JUNE 2021-2022

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

In January-June 2022 copper ores and concentrates reclaimed the first place in the list of top export items, equaling USD 533.1 million with 20.8 percent of total exports. The exports of ferroalloys totaled USD 301.6 million and their share in the total exports amounted to 11.8 percent. The motor cars exports occupied the third place standing at USD 269.3 million and constituting 10.5 percent of the total exports.







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The top import commodities in January-June 2022 were motor cars whose imports equaled USD 606.8 million (10.3 percent of the total imports). The petroleum and petroleum oils followed in the list with USD 576.8 million (9.7 percent of imports). The copper ores and concentrates were third in the top import commodity list with USD 416.3 million (7.0 percent of imports).




