AVERAGE MONTHLY NOMINAL EARNINGS OF EMPLOYEES

(II QUARTER, 2023)


In the II quarter of 2023, the average monthly nominal earnings in Georgia increased by 17.1 percent (263.2 Gel) compared to the same quarter of the previous year and amounted to 1 804.5 Gel.

The chart below presents the distribution of the average monthly earnings of employees in 2018-2023, by quarters.

According to the economic activity the highest monthly earnings were observed in the following fields:


- Information and communication – 3 799.8 Gel (increased by 22.2 percent compared to the corresponding period of the previous year)
- Financial and insurance activities – 3 181.4 Gel (increased by 19.1 percent)
- Construction – 2 590.3 Gel (increased by 18.9 percent)
- Professional, scientific and technical activities – 2 525.0 Gel (increased by 25.1 percent)

(GEL)**




In the II quarter of 2023, the average earnings equaled to 1 437.1 Gel for women, while 2 161.6 Gel for men. The annual growth of earnings amounted to 196.5 Gel (15.8%) for women and 333.2 Gel (18.2%) for men. In all sectors of the economy, the average monthly earnings of men were higher than women's.

The chart below presents the distribution of the average monthly earnings of employees by sex in 2018-2023, by quarters.

(GEL)**




In the II quarter of 2023, the average monthly earnings of hired employees in the business sector increased by 289.0 Gel (17.8%) and equaled 1 914.7 Gel. According to the economic activity the highest monthly earnings were observed in Information and communication (3 909 Gel, increased by 21.8 percent compared to the corresponding period of the previous year) and Professional, scientific and technical activities (2 895.4 Gel, increased by 26.5 percent).

The chart below presents the distribution of the average monthly earnings of employees in the business sector in 2018-2023, by quarters.

(GEL)**




In the II quarter of 2023, compared to the same quarter of the previous year, the average monthly earnings of hired employees in the non-business and financial sector increased by 213.4 Gel (15.3%) and amounted to 1 610.2 Gel. According to the economic activity the highest monthly earnings were observed in the Financial and insurance activities.

(GEL)**




Tbilisi and Adjara A.R. regions are leading regions by amount of the average earnings.
