EXTERNAL MERCHANDISE TRADE OF GEORGIA IN JANUARY-APRIL 2024

(PRELIMINARY)

In January-April 2024 the external merchandise trade (excluding non-declared trade) of Georgia amounted to USD 6 563.4 million, 2.7 percent lower year-on-year. The exports equaled 1 763.2 million (10.1 percent lower), while the imports stood at USD 4 800.2 million (0.3 percent higher). The negative trade balance was USD 3 037.1 million in January-April 2024 and its share in external trade turnover constituted 46.3 percent.






EXPORTS AND IMPORTS DYNAMICS BY MONTHS, 2022-2024

GEORGIAN EXPORT BY COUNTRY GROUPS IN JANUARY-APRIL 2024*








TOP TRADING PARTNERS BY EXPORTS IN JANUARY-APRIL 2023-2024




TOP TRADING PARTNERS BY IMPORTS IN JANUARY-APRIL 2023-2024



In January-April 2024 motor cars claimed the first place in the list of top export items, equaling USD 576.6 million with 32.7 percent of total exports. The exports of wine of fresh grapes totaled USD 126.5 million and their share in the total exports amounted to 7.2 percent. The exports of ferro-alloys occupied the third place standing at USD 82.4 million and constituting 4.7 percent of the total exports.



The top import commodities in January-April 2024 were motor cars, whose imports equaled USD 721.9 million (15.0 percent of the total imports). The petroleum and petroleum oils followed in the list with USD 422.6 million (8.8 percent of imports). The Medicaments put up in measured doses were third in the top import commodity list with USD 217.1 million (4.5 percent of imports).




